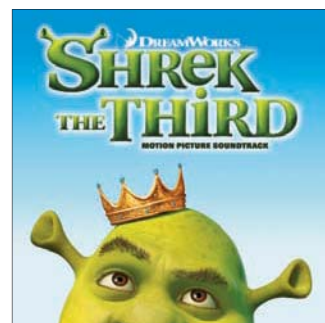
More than three decades ago, filmmaker George Lucas created a swashbuckling sci-fi saga called *Star Wars*. The rest, as they say, is history. Using his access to the Lucasfilm archives, *Star Wars* scholar (yes, scholar) J. W. Rinzler hurtles readers back in time for a behind-the-scenes look, including tales from the trenches, at Lucas' nearly decade-long quest to make the "little" movie that became a phenomenon 30 years ago this month.

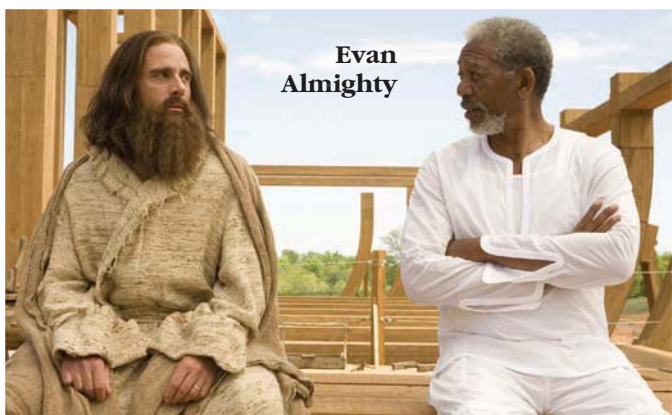

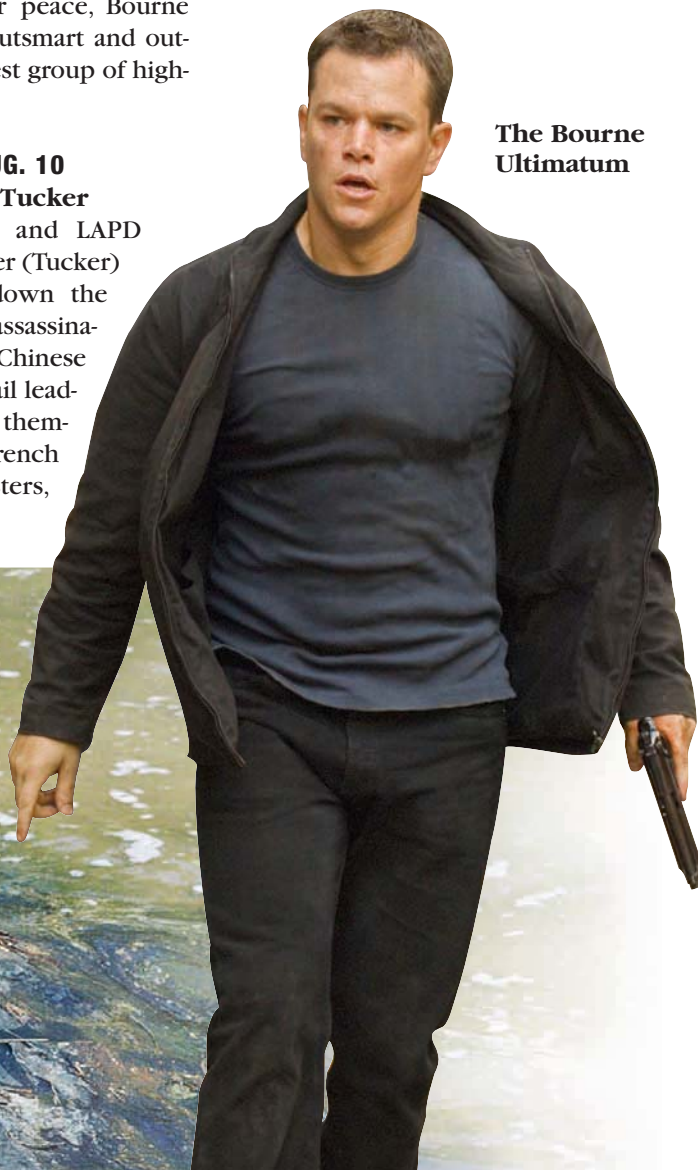

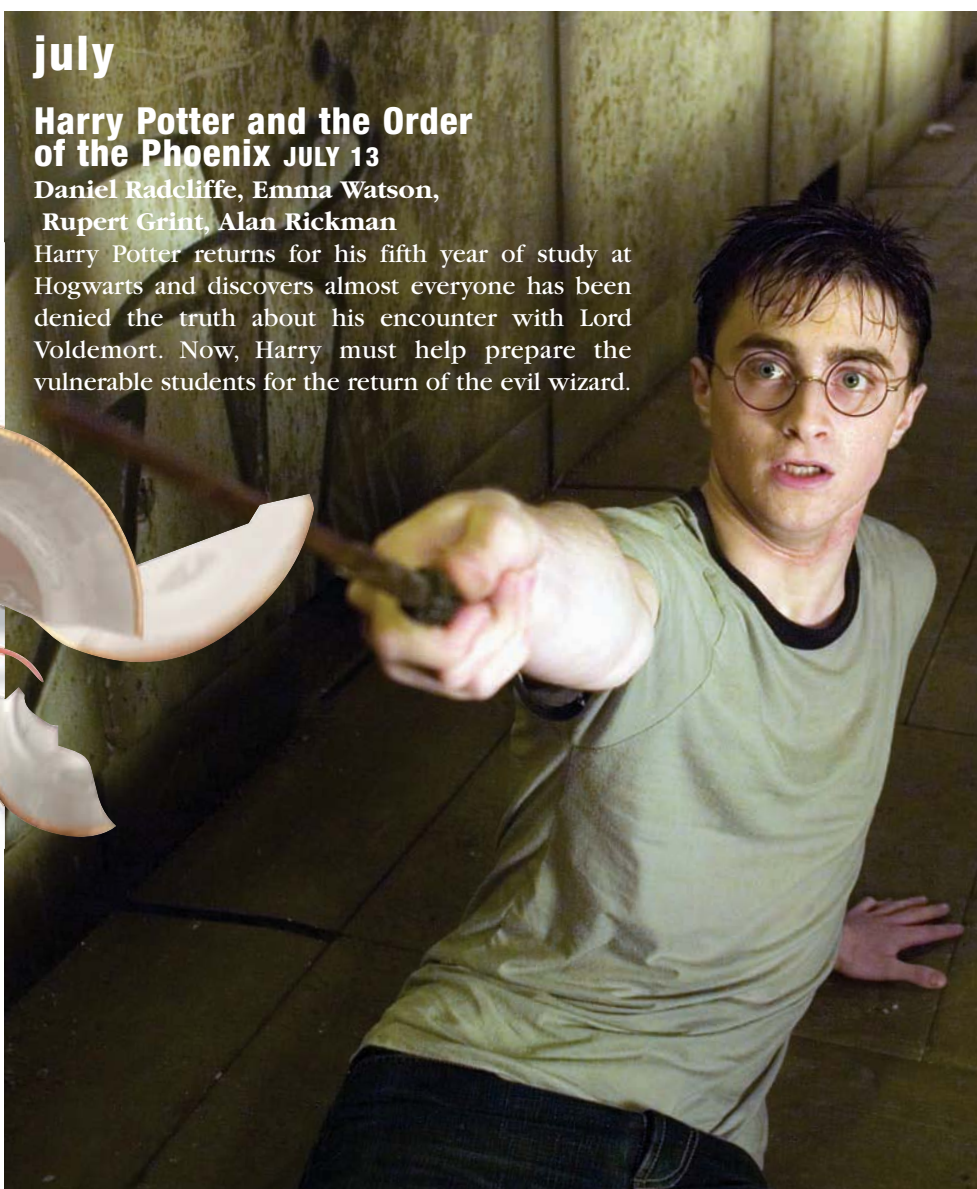

Revenge is oh so sweet

Clooney, Pitt, Damon and crew return for one final heist in Ocean's Thirteen

IF there were an actor in Hollywood who could draw an audience just on presence alone, it would undoubtedly be George Clooney. Guys want to be him, and women only wish they could snag him. He is, however, Hollywood's most eligible bachelor—*still*.

With his Golden Era movie star looks aside, the 46-year-old Oscar-winning actor (*Syriana*), turned director, is relied upon for more than his dashing looks. And as he again slips into his most suave role as Danny Ocean, we're reminded of his earning power at the box office.

With the first two *Ocean's* films, grossing almost \$800 million worldwide, Clooney has proven himself one of the few working actors worthy of "anchor" status.

His *Ocean's Thirteen* co-stars Brad Pitt and Matt Damon can boast membership in the same club—one whose doors open to stars who can carry entire projects, be they critically praised or maligned, and fill movie theater seats on their names alone.

Hot of the heels of the *Ocean's* films, *Thirteen*, reportedly the final film in the trilogy, is expected to lure audiences craving more of the same caper-driven action from one of the highest-profile casts to appear together in recent film history.



It's Clooney's character Danny Ocean that leads the pack but any heist could not be pulled off without *Ocean's* smooth crew—Don Cheadle, Bernie Mac, Elliott Gould, Scott Caan, Casey Affleck and Andy Garcia. "In large part, the film was motivated by everyone wanting to work together again," says director Soderbergh. "But it was always with the understanding that it had to be 'all in' or we were not doing it—everybody comes back or nobody comes back."

In addition to the "all for one" pact "*Thirteen* happened because we felt like we could do it better than *Twelve*," Clooney tells *iF* magazine. "Soderbergh and I were like, 'We know how to do this.' We found a really good reason to do it, which is revenge, which is always better than just making money. Maybe ten years from now I'll need a job, but right now we don't plan on another."

In *Ocean's Thirteen*, Garcia's ruthless casino owner Terry Benedict joins forces with Ocean and his crew to take down hated Vegas hotelier Willy Bank (Al Pacino).

"They're not stealing anything; they're letting everybody else rake it in," Clooney says. "You could say they're helping Bank give it away."

And, he pointed out, there's nothing quite like a casino floor packed with lucky players. "It's great to be around a table that's hot—like a craps table when people are winning," Clooney adds. "When you're around one that's on fire, the place just explodes. To have a whole casino on fire is everybody's fantasy."

So, too, is it a film fan's dream to enjoy so many A-list names acting in one film, let alone a trilogy.

Damon, who reprises his role as logistics man Linus Caldwell, sees his character

take a more active role in the heist, one naturally befitting his own constantly-elevating spot on Hollywood's list of go-to leading men. And naturally, he gets the girl—Bank's right-hand woman Abigail Sponder (Ellen Barkin). "I finally get the love interest in one of these movies," Damon quips. Or does he? Turns out Linus' attempts at stealing a heart might be tied to the heist itself.

For long-time Clooney collaborator Soderbergh, twists like these in the *Ocean's* films reflect a Robin Hood-esque love of taking from the rich and giving to the poor—criminals, in this case. But in the third film, revenge, rather than the thieves' financial gain, takes over as a driving force.

"I have always embraced the idea that these guys are thieves and con men," Soderbergh says. "But they're not entirely driven by money. Certainly, in this case, they are driven by friendship and revenge. The 'all for one and one for all' ethos dictates that when one of them is betrayed—especially in the way that their friend Reuben was betrayed—it's

payback time."

"It shows the kind of friends they

are, and I think that's something an audience can get behind right away," Garcia adds.

For those who have followed the *Ocean's* films on screen, and off, will know that being on set with this bunch is a complete riot—with Clooney as the notorious practical joker.

Their dynamic on-screen rapport

with each other probably explains the appeal of the films to audiences. Those feelings will no doubt be rekindled as the franchise returns to its Las Vegas roots for what could be the ultimate revenge job.

No doubt it will likely turn out to be another opportunity for Clooney—the patriarch of Hollywood's leading men—to prove once again why he's full of 21st century Hollywood cool.

A pirate's life for him

Johnny Depp sets sail one more time to play Captain Jack Sparrow in *Pirates 3*



FOR years, Depp was something of a bete noir among his fellow Hollywood stars. He was the guy you got for oddball roles in decidedly uncommercial pictures.

All that changed three years ago with a movie based, bizarrely, on a theme park ride. *Pirates of the Caribbean: The Curse of the Black Pearl* presented Depp with a once-in-a-lifetime chance to invent a truly iconic character: a charming, ne'er-do-well swashbuckler by the name of Captain Jack Sparrow.

The film was a surprise box-office monster and raked in \$305 million U.S. For Depp, so long the outsider, it meant he finally headlined a major studio picture. Best of all, he grabbed an Oscar nomination as Best Actor. He didn't win, of course—the award went to Sean Penn, another outcast suddenly welcomed into the fold.

The supposed end to the trilogy, *At World's End*, finds Sparrow's friends Will Turner (Orlando Bloom) and Elizabeth Swann (Keira Knightley) joining forces with Captain Barbossa (Geoffrey Rush) in a quest to save the pirate from his mind-bending trap in Davy Jones' locker while the ghost ship, the *Flying Dutchman* and Davy Jones, under control of the East India Trading Company, wreak havoc across the Seven Seas.

Depp still professes to be shocked at the turnaround in his career. "I had gotten used to the idea of never having a successful film," he says, with a smile. "The fact that audiences came in and supported me was a win-win situation. That's an enormous surprise as well—the fact that people took the character in."

Nowadays he's picking up regular pay checks in the region of \$18 million per movie. Still, he denies he does it for hard cash. As for the *Pirates* sequels, Depp claims it was purely and simply down to the influence of one man: Captain Jack Sparrow.

"I very selfishly enjoyed playing the character," he confides. "It's not as if there's an evil moment with me in a back room, counting money. It's never been about that with me. I'm not looking forward to saying goodbye to Jack Sparrow."

So if a *Pirates IV* appears on the horizon, would he do it?

"If everything was in the right place and the story was good, I'd stay on the ride, for sure. Just to be able to put the gear back on and become Captain Jack again. It's very satisfying."
